In artworks such as "La Porte Bleue" and "Red Shutters", Shaughnessy focuses her compositions on architecture using color and light.

"La Porte Bleue" stands out with a deep blue door and pink climbing roses in front of a bright stone facade and behind an intricately patinated iron garden fence. "My work has focused primarily on landscapes from places where I have been and love – Ireland, France, Scotland, the Cape Cod shore— or here at home in Vermont. Of late, I have narrowed my focus from the broad view to tighter images or ones that might be overlooked." -Marianne Shaughnessy
